## Programs

**PreSchool Skate** is a program designed to introduce very young skaters to the ice. (5 & Under)

**CanSkate** is Skate Canada's flagship learn-to-skate program for beginners of any age that teaches fundamental movements and basic skills. (5 & Up)

**JumpSkate** is an introduction to StarSkate program which focuses on developing skills necessary to excel in StarSkate.

**STARSkate** offers opportunities for skaters of all ages to develop fundamental figure skating skills in the areas of ice dance, skating skills, free skate and interpretive skating. Unique in Canada, this program teaches figure skating skills in a group and/or private lesson format in a progressive and sequential manner and includes specifically designed awards and incentives.

**SynchroSkate** or "synchro" is a specialized discipline of skating involving groups of eight or more skaters performing various group formations and maneuvers.

All skating club members (except PowerSkate) are required to give a \$100 post dated check (dated March 31, 2009) in lieu of 20 volunteer hours (per skater) that must be completed throughout the season in order to have their check returned. Any member that does not complete their hours will have to pay out their time at \$5 per hour.
